Within the last year, Kroger has adopted a New Privacy Policy to Never Share a Customer's Personal Information with anyone; unfortunately this new policy applies to your participation in the Community Rewards Program as well.

At this time, families are no longer receiving tuition credits based on their individual Kroger purchases. Due to the new privacy policy there is no way for the SCRIP Coordinator to disburse credits to families for purchases made because Kroger is no longer providing us with that information.

Although we will no longer be able to receive individual family credits for our purchases, we would still like you to consider participating in the Kroger Community Rewards Program. Although not allowed to track the family purchases individually, Kroger has agreed to continue to send Powers a donation based on our purchases as a group. If you would like to continue to be a part of this program to help earn funds for Powers, please re-enroll in the Kroger Community Rewards Program. All participants must sign up again for the program in order to continue earning funds for the school during the 2013 – 2014 school year.
