Job Description:

- Explains and enforces safety rules and regulations.
- Select, stores, orders, issues, and inventories equipment, materials, and supplies used; keeps record of receipts and expenditures. Recommend purchase of equipment, supplies, and uniforms as appropriate.
- Confers with students, parents, and school counselor to resolve student problems.
- Take necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials and facilities. Overseeing the safety conditions of the facility/area in which assigned activity/event is conducted at all times, especially, when students are present.
