Concerned Citizen Grant

Concerned Citizen Media is offering a \$1,000 grant to help an African-American male or female student remain at Powers for his/her Junior or Senior year.

CONCERNED CITIZEN GRANT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

3.4 or higher GPA

Noteworthy community engagement (e.g., mentoring, tutoring, etc, helping others in some way)

African-American male or female

Rising Junior or rising Senior

CONCERNED CITIZEN GRANT AWARD

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award of \$1,000 for the academic school year at Powers Catholic High School. The award is to be used during the traditional academic year (fall through spring) for tuition.

The award is paid by reducing the total amount of tuition by the award at receipt of the scholarship. If the student withdraws from Powers Catholic High School, the scholarship amount is to be prorated over 12 months and the balance of the scholarship will be forfeited.

CONCERNED CITIZEN GRANT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants are asked to submit the following documents for eligibility:

1. A completed Student Data Sheet

2. A short essay discussing an extracurricular or Christian service activity that you have participated in. Select one of these activities and describe what you learned through your participation.

*Please do not staple application materials.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Selection of the grant recipient is based upon academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school, parish and community activities, and information about goals and aspirations

Scholarship recipients are made solely by the Concerned Citizen grant committee at Powers Catholic High School. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Powers Catholic High School as final. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Selection(s) will be made without regard to race or gender.

OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS

Except as previously outlined, no obligations are to be imposed upon the student(s) as a grant recipient. Students are to notify the Concerned Citizen grant committee of any changes in address, school enrollment or other relevant information.

A thank you letter to Dr. CharlesThomas / Concerned Citizen is requested within two weeks of your notification as the recipient.
