

You've been exposed to COVID.... Now what??

Are you fully vaccinated* OR have you had COVID within the last 90 days?

**Fully vaccinated means 2 weeks have passed since you received the last dose in the vaccine series*



NO



YES



You must stay home and quarantine for **14 days** from the last date of exposure and monitor for symptoms. Notify the school.

At this time, MDHHS and the GCHD are NOT allowing a test out of quarantine option



Have you developed symptoms?



NO



You may exit quarantine after 14 days as long as you remain symptom free.



YES



Get a PCR test right away.



Positive result: Notify the school. You will need to isolate until your contagious period is over.

Negative Result: Remain in quarantine for the full 14 days from exposure

You do **NOT** need to quarantine after being in close contact with someone with COVID-19 **UNLESS** you develop symptoms.

If you do develop symptoms, you should isolate and get a COVID-19 test right away.

If the exposure is someone who lives in the same household (parent, sibling) the quarantine period may be up to 24 days. The health department will help make this determination (10 days for the contagious period + 14 days of quarantine afterward)
