



WILLIAM & JEANNE MARTIN SCHOLARSHIP

Established by William & Jeanne Martin

The William & Jeanne Martin Scholarship was established in 2019 in honor of the Martin Family's love of and commitment to Catholic education. Mr. Martin was a graduate of St. Michael's Flint and the couple's children and grandchildren are proud graduates of St. Robert Catholic School and Powers Catholic.

The Martin Scholarship is intended to support students seeking a Catholic education and who exemplify the virtues of leadership, integrity and faith. The recipient should demonstrate a strong academic record or desire to persevere, a record of service to the community and parish, and leadership to peers either in an academic, faith or extracurricular setting.

The Martin Scholarship is awarded to one student annually at a value of \$2,500 with the option of being renewed for a second year upon application and review.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicant must apply for tuition assistance and have demonstrated financial need.
2. Applicant must demonstrate leadership in and outside of the classroom, including community involvement.
4. Applicant must demonstrate strong academic effort.
5. Applicant must provide one letter of recommendation from a school, extracurricular or community leader.
6. Applicant must submit an essay that speaks how he or she demonstrates leadership, lives his or her faith and/or supports his or her community through service.

Application Procedure

Applicant must apply for tuition assistance through FACTS in order to determine financial need.

Applicant must submit completed scholarship application, letter of recommendation and completed essay (see above) by May 1st to the Office of Advancement & Alumni Relations.

Selection of Recipients

Recipients will be chosen by the William and Jeanne Martin Scholarship selection committee after review of the completed application, letter of recommendation and student essay. The recipient will be notified of the scholarship award by August 15th. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Powers Catholic High School as final. Not all applicants will be selected as recipients.

* Selection(s) will be made without regard to race or gender.

Obligation of Recipients

Recipients must maintain virtue of leadership in academics, faith and service in order for the scholarship to be renewed the subsequent year. Students must submit an essay speaking to an experience where this leadership was demonstrated prior to renewal. Recipients are asked to submit a thank you letter to the William & Jeanne Martin Scholarship Committee within three weeks of notification of the award.
