Mrs. Mary Milne Scholarship

Established by the Milne Family.

This scholarship was established in 2014 by the Milne Family in recognition of Mrs. Mary Milne.

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide \$1,000 for tuition assistance to a student attending Powers Catholic High School who meets the criteria set forth by the Powers Catholic High School Administration.

Mary Hayes Milne was born in Detroit, Michigan on February 10, 1928. She attended St. Rita's High School.

Mary married, Thomas J. Milne on April 4, 1956 in Swartz Creek. They lived in Grand Blanc, Michigan and raised five children.

Mary thought it was important that all of her children attend Catholic School, but finances did not allow for this to happen. She provided her children with the basic foundation to become productive and caring individuals. She was very active in her church.

Mrs. Mary Milne Scholarship Award Criteria

1. Financial need
2. Applicants must have one or more sibling enrolled at a Genesee County Catholic School.
3. Applicants may be of Catholic or non-Catholic Faith
4. The student has demonstrated high levels of integrity, and honesty while participating in extracurricular activities
5. The applicant must submit an essay - Explain why a Catholic education is important to you and your family?

This scholarship was established in December, 2014 by The Milne Family in tribute to Mary Milne.



The Mrs. Mary Milne Scholarship Award

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide \$1,000 for tuition assistance to a student attending Powers Catholic High School who meets the criteria set forth by the Powers Catholic High School Administration.

THE AWARD

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award of \$1,000 for the academic school year at Powers Catholic High School.

The award is to be used during the traditional academic year (fall through spring) for tuition. The award is paid by reducing the total amount of tuition by the award at receipt of the scholarship. If the student withdraws from Powers Catholic High School, the scholarship amount is to be pro-rated over 12 months and the balance of the scholarship will be forfeited.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Students must send a) completed application, b) one letter of recommendation (see next paragraph), c) a completed essay found in criteria.

The application submission letter of recommendation may come from a Principal, Pastor, Teacher, Scout Leader, Coach, or other Community Leader and should confirm the student and family's service to the respective Parish or School, or community.

Selection of Recipients

Selection of the scholarship recipient is based upon family size, demonstrated participation in school, parish and community activities, and the appraisal by a teacher, counselor, principal, priest, scout leader, or other community leader contained in the letter of recommendation.

Scholarship recipients are chosen solely by the selection committee at Powers Catholic High School. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Powers Catholic High School as final. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Selection(s) will be made without regard to race or gender.

Obligation of Recipients

Except as previously outlined, no obligations are to be imposed upon the student(s) as a scholarship recipient. Students are to notify the Powers Catholic Selection Committee of any changes in address, school enrollment or other relevant information.

A thank you letter to the Milne Family will be submitted to Powers Catholic Advancement Office within two weeks of your notification as the recipient.
