



## **Powers Catholic High School Owen D. Fisher Technology Fund**

The Owen D. Fisher Technology Fund was established in 2005 by David and Vida Fisher and Katie Fisher MacDonald (Powers Class of 1998) to honor and keep the memory of their son and brother, Owen Fisher. It was, for many years, a scholarship fund for students entering law enforcement. Remembering the cost of books, and wishing to help current and future students, the family requested that the fund be developed to assist incoming and/or current students with these costs.

The purpose of this fund now is to provide an iPad tablet or book(s) to a student attending Powers Catholic High School who meets the criteria set forth by the Powers Catholic High School Administration.

Owen attended St. Pius X School and continued his Catholic education at Powers, graduating in 2000. He played varsity soccer and was a co-captain during his senior year. He played jv basketball and was in one of the earliest Kairos groups. While at Powers, he developed a talent for writing that flourished in college. A friend who could be counted on when help was needed, Owen possessed a sense of fair play and civility practiced both at home and at school. He benefitted from his Powers Catholic High School education.

Owen found his passion in college: law enforcement. He had found what he wanted to do with his life and that was to serve his community. Upon completing his degree, he was inducted into the national junior college honors society. Shortly after, he joined the Flint Police Department. Flint Police Officer Owen Fisher was killed in the line of duty on July 16, 2005. He had served with the City of Flint Police Department for four months at the time of his death at age 23.

The Fisher Family would like the fund to serve as a challenge fund to encourage other families to contribute and/or match this gift.

### **OWEN D. FISHER ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

#### **Financial Need**

Recipient has met all financial obligations to their respective Catholic Elementary or Powers Catholic High School, if appropriate.

## **OWEN D. FISHER TECHNOLOGY FUND AWARD**

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide \$500.00 for the purchase of a required iPad tablet or books to a student attending Powers Catholic High School who meets the criteria set forth by the Powers Catholic High School Administration.

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award of up to \$500.00 for the academic school year at Powers Catholic High School.

The award is paid by the disbursement of an iPad tablet or required book(s)

## **OWEN D. FISHER APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

**Applicants are asked to submit the following documents for eligibility:**

1. A completed Student Data Sheet
2. A completed essay explaining what stands out to you about Owen and why it is important to you to attend Powers Catholic High School.

## **SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS**

Selection(s) will be made without regard to race or gender.

## **OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS**

Except as previously outlined, no obligations are to be imposed upon the student(s) as a scholarship recipient. Students are to notify the Owen D. Fisher Scholarship committee of any changes in address, school enrollment or other relevant information. The Scholarship committee reserves the right to review GPA and/or service projects to determine if the award will be renewed.

A thank you letter to the Fisher family is requested within two weeks of your notification as the recipient.
