Established and funded by Pat's Family and Friends

Pat Hearn's served as Powers Catholic's athletic director from 2003-2009. Prior to his work at Powers Catholic, he had spent 40+ years in education as a teacher, counselor, administrator and as a beloved baseball coach at Madison Heights Bishop Foley and North Branch High School. Powers Catholic has held a special place in his heart for 20+ years as his two sons graduated in 04' and 06'. Pat's wife, Kathy, was a teacher in Catholic Education for over 35 years as well, and both of his sons are currently teachers as well.

During Pat's final days he reflected with many former students, colleagues, players, parents and many others about his journey through the education system and his great pride on the work he did for and with others. It is obvious that Pat's reach to his students and student athletes was far and carried through generations. It was suggested that he continue a legacy of giving back and helping people through an academic scholarship that carries his name.

Award Recipients

1. Financial Need: family must have completed FACTS forms
2. Any grade level
3. Student value in education and giving back
4. Student has met all financial requirements for elementary school, or Powers Catholic
5. (Not mandatory requirement, but please indicate if a parent/guardian is an **educator**)

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Current G.P.A of 2.7 or higher (if not an incoming Freshmen) (please indicate in application)
2. **One** letter of recommendation from a principal, pastor, teacher, scout leader, coach or other community leader. The letter of recommendation should confirm the student and family's service to school or community. Students should allow at least two weeks for the letter of recommendation.
3. **A short essay** on why you would/ or why you attend Powers Catholic, and how the education received there will allow you to give back to your community with the same reach as Pat. Please indicate your motivation for success in education, and why there is a value on both aspects, education and giving back.

PAT HEARNS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award of up to \$500 for **one** academic school year at Powers Catholic High School, with the ability to apply again the following year(s). The award is to be used during the traditional academic year (fall through spring) for tuition. The award is paid by reducing the total amount of tuition by the award at receipt of the scholarship. If the student withdraws from Powers Catholic High School, the scholarship amount is to be pro-rated over 12 months and the balance of the scholarship will be forfeited.

Scholarship recipients are made solely by the **PAT HEARNS SCHOLARSHIP** committee. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Powers Catholic High School as final. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Selection(s) will be made without regard to race or gender

Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on, financial need, academic standing, and upon reflection of the essay to determine like-minded giving that represents the selflessness and giving back to his community that Pat demonstrated over his 40+ years in his career.
