This scholarship was established to honor Guy and Theodora Morgan and their commitment to Catholic Education. Guy and his five siblings all attended St. Agnes & St. Roberts. His mother was also a teacher at those schools. Guy was in the very first graduating class at Powers in 1971. He served many years on their Board of Education. Theo was a Catholic School teacher/ administrator at St. Mary's in Flint and Holy family in Grand Blanc. Their two children are graduates of Powers Catholic. They believe a Catholic school education is dedicated to calling forth our loving God day by day. It is a commitment to heart and spirit as well as mind.

### **GUY AND THEODORA MORGAN SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

#### Financial Need

Graduates of a Genesee County Catholic Elementary School

Student has demonstrated high levels of integrity, honesty, and sportsmanship while participating in activities at his or her parish or school

Student and family are active and participating members of a Genesee County Catholic Parish

Demonstrates leadership through participation in school, community, and parish activities, including individual and family participation

Demonstrates academic potential through commitment to classroom work and assignments

Recipients have met all financial obligations to their respective Catholic Elementary or Powers Catholic High School.

### **GUY AND THEODORA MORGAN SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

If selected as a recipient, the two students will receive an award of \$2,500 for the upcoming academic school year at Powers Catholic High School.

The award is to be used during the traditional academic year (fall through spring) for tuition. The award is paid by reducing the total amount of tuition by the award at receipt of the scholarship. The scholarship amount is prorated over a 12 month period. If the student withdraws from Powers Catholic High School, the scholarship amount is to be pro-rated over 12 months and the balance of the scholarship will be forfeited. Payment will be made from the Board of Trustees Scholarship Fund.

## **GUY AND THEODORA MORGAN APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

**Applicants are asked to submit the following documents for eligibility:**

1. A completed Student Data Sheet
2. One letter of recommendation from a principal, pastor, teacher, scout leader, coach or other community leader. The letter of recommendation should confirm the student and family's service to the respective parish, school or community. Students should allow at least two weeks for the letter of recommendation.
3. Most recent middle school (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades) transcript OR high school transcript
4. Completed essays: (a) Explaining why you would like to attend Powers Catholic High School and (b) Explaining the importance of community service and/or extracurricular activities as a part of your development as a citizen of your community

## **SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS**

Selection of the scholarship recipient is based upon academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school, parish and community activities, statement of goals and aspirations, family circumstances, and the appraisal by a teacher, counselor, principal, priest, scout leader, or other community leader contained in the letter of recommendation.

Scholarship recipients are made solely by the Guy and Theodora Morgan scholarship committee at Powers Catholic High School. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Powers Catholic High School as final. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Selection(s) will be made without regard to race or gender.

## **OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS**

Except as previously outlined, no obligations are to be imposed upon the student(s) as a scholarship recipient. Students are to notify the Guy and Theodora Morgan Scholarship committee of any changes in address, school enrollment or other relevant information. The Scholarship committee reserves the right to review GPA and/or service projects to determine if the award will be renewed.

A thank you letter to the Morgan family is requested within two weeks of your notification as the recipient.
